Chardonnay 2018

Vineyard:

Clone: Bernard selection 76 own rooted - Vines planted in 2014.

Sourced solely from Lonestar Creek Vineyard, Upper Yarra Valley. C Block is yellow duplex soil.

Fruit picked on 2 March, 2018

Winemaking:

Winemaker: Franco D'Anna

Total crush: 108 dozen - Crushed, pressed & cooled at receipt, barrel primary and random natural malolactic fermentation.

Indigenous yeast.

Maturation: nine months on lees in new (18%) and used French Barrique (225l)

Cold stabilised, filtered and bottled 5 December, 2018.

Contains sulphites

Tasting Notes (update mid 2019):

Brilliant pale straw in colour, this wine is an elegant expression of regional cool climate character with aromas of citrus and white peach, complemented by vanilla from the new oak.

A medium weight in the mouth with ripe fruit which broadens with a touch of malo character. Grip from crisp acidity, gives the wine drive along the palate. Great length and a clean finish.

Vegan friendly: no animal products used.
